# **AKC Trick Evaluation with Anne**

The Novice Level Tricks are easy, and most any freestyle dog should have no trouble with the Intermediate and Advanced as well. There are a few short videos that help with training a few of the tricks on the AKC Trick Dog website page. I would encourage everyone to think about it. The test is fun and low-pressure. Please bring your paperwork and any props that you might need. The test will be done in the dorm lobby area. Anne will be in located Room #4 if she is not in the dorm area.

# Camp Rules

Thank you in advance for your cooperation in following these rules. We try to keep the rules to a minimum, yet they are required to keep everyone safe, happy, and to meet the standards of our host, The Salvation Army.

- ✓ Smoking will be allowed, in designated areas only.
- ✓ Alcohol is not allowed on campgrounds.
- ✓ Driving is not permitted on the grass.
- ✓ Parking is allowed in designated areas only (across the road from the camper drop-off).
- $\checkmark\,\,$  Only humans are allowed in the dining hall during dinner times.
- ✓ Dogs must be in good health, free of contagious disease, parasites and fleas.
- ✓ Dogs must be reasonably well-socialized and house trained and non-aggressive towards people.
- ✓ Dogs that need "space" should wear a yellow bandana to prevent unwanted confrontations.
- ✓ Dogs must be crated when left alone in the dorm rooms. If your dog is left unattended and causes damage (e.g., chews up the furniture, scratches the door) you will be responsible for repair fees.
- ✓ Dogs must be leashed during classes and all camp activities.
- ✓ Flexi-leads are not allowed at camp.
- ✓ It is your responsibility to clean up after your dogs. Poop buckets will be placed around the camp, and plastic "hand" bags will be available. There will be a designated exercise area.
- ✓ Two dogs are allowed with you unless you are unable to control them effectively. Only 1 dog out at a time.

# Salvation Army Lake Camp

N8725 Army Lake Rd East Troy, WI 53120

#### From Milwaukee and north

- 1. Take I-43 or I-45 south to I-894
- 2. At intersection of I-894 and I-43 go southwest on I-43 towards Beloit for 16 miles
- 3. Exit I-43 at sign reading "exit 43 WI-83 to Waterford/Mukwonago"
- 4. Turn right on WI-83 and go northwest for 600 feet
- 5. Turn left on Bay View Road and go west for 0.6 mile (First Stop Light)
- 6. Turn left on CR-ES and go southwest for 2.7 mile
- 7. Turn right on Army Lake Road and go southwest for 0.7 miles to Army Lake Camp

#### From Madison and northwest

- 1. Take I-90 to I-94 and go east 47 miles
- 2. Exit I-94 at sign reading "exit 287 WI-83 to Hartland/Wales"
- 3. Turn right on WI-83 and go south for 14 miles
- 4. Turn right on CR-ES and go southwest for 3.5 miles
- 5. Turn right on Army Lake Road and go southwest for 0.7 miles to Army Lake Camp

#### From Rockford and southwest

- 1. Take I-90 north
- 2. Exit I-43 north and go northeast 38 miles
- 3. Exit I-43 at sign reading "exit 38 WI-20 to East Troy/Waterford"
- 4. Turn left on WI-20 and go west 0.3 miles
- 5. Turn right on CR-ES and go northeast for 1.1 miles
- 6. Turn left on Army Lake Road to Army Lake Camp 0.1 mile

### From Chicago and southeast

- 1. Take I-94 north into Wisconsin
- 2. Exit I-94 at WI-20
- 3. Turn left on WI-20 and go west for 24 miles
- 4. Turn right on CR-ES and go northeast for 1.1 miles
- 5. Turn left on Army Lake Road to Army Lake Camp 0.1 mile

Please look for the signs with the Dancers with Woofs logo Please unload, take to room, park, and then register. (Joe will be there to assist you)
